Philippians 4:6-7


Observe:

The Word: Peace

eirēnē (eye-RAY-nay)
Peace, Wholeness, Rest, Quietness

 A settled wholeness rooted in Christ.
Something that remains even when life is unsettled.

-  Absence of difficulty or trouble
-  Control over circumstances

Peace and the Abundant Life

Living the Abundant Life

Consider: Peace in Three Directions

Biblical peace is not limited to how we feel; it shapes how we relate and transforms us.

- **Upward** — Peace with God through Christ
- **Inward** — A settled heart rooted in trust
- **Outward** — Peace expressed in our relationships

Which direction feels most unsettled right now? How might Christ's peace speak into it?

Abundant life begins not when everything is resolved, but when the peace of Christ takes root and holds us together.
